



Tiberto Brandolini d'Adda

Born in Lausanne (Switzerland) in 1948 and a graduate in commercial law from the University of Parma.

From 1972 to 1974, Brandolini d'Adda gained his initial work experience working in the international department of Fiat S.p.A. and at Lazard Bank in London.

In 1975, he was appointed Assistant to the Director General for Enterprise Policy at the European Economic Commission in Brussels.

He subsequently joined Ifint, as General Manager for France. In 1985, he was appointed General Manager for Europe and then in 1993 Managing Director of the Exor Group (formerly Ifint), where he served as Vice Chairman and Managing Director from 2003 until 2007.

He has extensive international experience as a main board director of several companies: Ifil, le Continent Iard, le Continent Vie, Bolloré Investissement, Espirito Santo Financial Group, Société Foncière Lyonnaise, Safic Alcan and Château Margaux.

Mr. Brandolini d'Adda also served as Chairman of the Supervisory Board of Worms & Cie and member of the Supervisory Board of Club Méditerranée. Since the beginning of 1992, he held several positions at Club Med, including his tenure as Chairman of the Supervisory Board from 1997 to 2003.

He is presently member of the Board of Directors of Vittoria Assicurazioni and Société Générale de Surveillance Holding S.A. (SGS), Switzerland.

In February 2006, he was appointed Vice Chairman of IFIL.

Mr. Brandolini d'Adda serves as Chairman of Sequana S.A. (formerly Worms & Cie).

He is General Partner of Giovanni Agnelli e C. S.a.p.A. and Vice Chairman of Exor S.p.A., the company formed through the merger between IFI and IFIL Investments.

Brandolini d'Adda is *Chevalier de la Légion d'Honneur*.

He has been a member of the Board of Directors of Fiat S.p.A. since 30 May 2004.
