**Camillo Rossotto**, 47, holds a degree in Political Science from the University of Torino and an MBA from New York University. He joined the Fiat Group in 1989, in the International Corporate Finance area of Fiat S.p.A.

He covered roles of increasing responsibility in the financial area and gained significant international experience while working for Fiat Finance in Germany, Brazil and the United States.

After a period as Group Treasurer of Barilla, Mr. Rossotto returned to the Fiat Group as Treasurer of Fiat Auto and CFO of Fidis, the former consumer finance arm of the automobiles business. In 2005, he became Treasurer of the US subsidiary CNH, later also becoming CFO of CNH Capital.

In 2009, he was appointed CEO of FGA Capital, the 50/50 joint venture between Fiat Group Automobiles and Crédit Agricole which manages the sales finance activities.
